



REGULATIONS for Carpathians Open Muay Thai Cup

1. Object and purpose:

- to popularize Muay Thai boxing among the population of Ukraine;
- to improve sportsmen and referees' mastership;
- to reveal young and talented sportsmen.

2. Time frames and location.

The competition will take place from February 28, 2013 to March 3, 2013 in Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine.

The arrival date, participants registration, credentials committee gathering, and the meeting between judges and team representatives will be held on February 28, 2013 from 8.00 to 17.00 at the following address: Ivano-Frankivsk, Vasylianok Str. 1, floor 4. The competition itself will take place from March 1, 2013 to March 3, 2013 at the address: Ivano-Frankivsk, Naberezhna Str. 42.

Departure date – March 4, 2013.

3. Competition key personnel:

General supervision and organisation of the competition are conducted by Regional Department of Family, Youth and Sports of Ivano-Frankivsk Regional State Administration, NGO of Ukrainian Federation of Muay Thai boxing and Ivano-Frankivsk Regional Federation of Muay Thai boxing.

4. Participants

Regional combined teams, clubs combined teams, sports clubs combined teams, federation institutions, and sports organizations of AR of Crimea, Kyiv and Sevastopol are allowed to participate in Carpathians Open Muay Thai Cup.

Sportsmen born in 1996 or older, with sports category no lower than I, are allowed to participate.

The team is to consist of 21 participants – 14 men and 7 women.

For sportsmen of 1996 year of birth and older the fights will consist of 3 rounds lasting 3 minutes each, with a break of 1 minute between rounds.

Weight Categories:

Men: 45 kg, 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63,3 kg, 67 kg, 71 kg, 75 kg, 81 kg, 86 kg, 91 kg, +91 kg.

Women: 45 kg, 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63,3 kg, 67 kg, 71 kg, 75 kg, + 75 kg.

5. The Competition Program

February 28, 2013	08.00 – 17.00	Participants' credentials committee.

6. Sport outfit

The competition is held in accordance with working regulations of organizing Muay Thai boxing competitions in Ukraine confirmed by the Federation and approved by the Ministry of Ukraine of Family, Youth and Sports that corresponds to the international rules of Muay Thai box.

Each of the participants are to have the appropriate competition form and outfit: boxing shorts, sleeveless sports shirt (the colour of the shirt should correspond to the chosen corner of the boxing ring), boxing helmet, boxing gloves, and mouthpiece, bandage, legs and elbows protectors.

At the opening ceremony, all participants are to be in the appropriate competition form of the region, club. Teams must also have a flag of the region (size 120x90).

7. Awarding

Sportsmen who won I, II and III places in each weight category will be awarded with diplomas and medals. We will determine the best Thai boxer. Teams that took I, II and III team places will be awarded with the goblets.

8. Financing of the competition.

Competition organizers bear all necessary financial costs for organizing and conducting the competition: competition place rent, awarding of the participants with diplomas and medals, medical insurance, and competitions refereeing (dwelling, nourishment, **on call** passenger fare of referees).

Business trip expenses of other participants, coaches and referees (traveling expenses, food and lodging, daily subsistence allowance and salary) are borne by their sending organizations.

Dwelling cost - 120 UAH.

9. Safety during competitions and sports facilities arrangement.

Responsibility for arranging training places and carrying out fights is borne by the Regional Department of Family, Youth and Sports of Ivano-Frankivsk Regional State Administration and Ivano-Frankivsk Regional Federation of Muay Thai Boxing.

All participants are to have insurance policy in case of accidents due to the increased health risk for the sportsmen who participate in Muay Thai boxing.

1. Personal application forms should be handed in to the credentials committee on the day of arrival during weighing. An official application form should be attested by the the Regional Department of Physical Culture and Sports (the application should contain a seal of regional sports clinic, a date against each participant name, doctor's signiture who conducted the medical examination and round seal, physician-in-chief's signiture of the regional sports clinic) three days before arriving at the competition. Other medical records are not valid.

2. Passport or other valid ID.

3. Insurane policy valid for the duration of the competition.

4. Federation Member Sports ID (Passport) of standard form.

In case of absence one of the listed documents, sportsmen will not allowed to participate. Participants who timely confirmed their participation in the competition will provided with lodging by the competition organizers.

Invited referees must have Passport, ID number, filled in and sealed business trip letter, and travel documents for a round trip.

These Regulations are the official invitation for the competition.
